**STUDENT EXAMINATION PROCEDURES FOR ALL STUDENTS**

**ATTENDANCE:** A parent/guardian must report a student absence by contacting the school by 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the exam. (905-851-6643)

Absences due to illness will require a medical certificate **and** students will be required to take a make-up exam at a later date.

Absences without a legitimate reason will result in a mark of "0" being entered for that exam.

Absences due to personal vacation are not permitted and will also result in a mark of "0" for that exam.

**PUNCTUALITY:** Students should report to their examination room by 8:50 a.m.

**Grade 12 students writing their Period 4 class exam on June 20 should report to their assigned exam room by 12:15 p.m.**

Students who arrive late (after exam attendance has been submitted to the office) must sign in at the Main Office and obtain an admit slip before going to the examination room.

**NO EXTRA TIME WILL BE GIVEN** to students who arrive late.

*All exams are at least 1½ hours in length. Students will not be dismissed before 10:30 a.m. during the formal exam schedule.*

**TRANSPORTATION:** Regular school bussing will be available until Wednesday, June 28, 2017 at the regular times.

**CANCELLATIONS:** In the case of bus cancellation on an exam day, that entire day's examinations will be re-scheduled for Tuesday, June 27, 2017.

**CHEATING: Expected Behaviour** - Formal examinations are to be taken without any assistance from peers or other sources.

If you are caught cheating on a test or an examination, you will be given a mark of "0." No other chance will be permitted for a make-up exam and the incident will be recorded in the office.

**LOCKERS:** There will be no access to lockers during the examination period.

**CAFETERIA:** Cafeteria will be available from 8:00 to 8:45 a.m. for students who require a place to study.

Cafeteria services will not be available during exams. The last day of service will be Tuesday, June 20, 2017.

**TEXTBOOKS:** Students must return all school textbooks to the subject teacher before the exam or at the beginning of the exam day.

Students who have lost or damaged a school textbook will be required to pay for the replacement cost of the textbook.

**UNIFORM:** Full and proper uniform is required to be admitted to the examination.

**LIBRARY:** The library will be closed during exams. All library books/materials should be returned prior to June 12, 2017.

Any outstanding fines must be cleared by June 12, 2017.

**OTHER EXPECTATIONS:** Once the teacher dismisses students from an exam, it is expected they leave the school quickly and quietly since there may be other exams still in session.

**PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** All personal electronic devices (such as cell phones, ipods, etc.) are not to be used and must be turned off and kept out of sight. Failure to follow this policy will result in the device being confiscated by the teacher and may result in may result in loss of full or part marks on the exam.
