### **Accessing Student Timetables**

### **Anaphylactic, Asthmatic, Diabetic Students**

Upon registering your child at Father Bressani C. H. S., you should have completed information and/or YCDSB documentation to support your child's medical conditions. I have attached a copy of the S15a if

- you have not submitted the S15a Form (SECONDARY ADMINISTRATION OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION FOR ANAPHYLAXIS)
- or
- there has been a recent diagnosis or change in your child's medical condition or needs relating to any of the following: Anaphylaxis / Asthma / or Diabetes;
- ★ Epipens can be dropped off at the main office by the student on the first day of school if your child's Epipen has expired and needs to be replaced or **you need to provide us with an Epipen**

## Re-Entry Plan Highlights

-Students in Grades 1 to 12 are required to wear masks indoors and on buses

-Students are not required to wear masks outdoors

-Secondary students can go home for lunch

-Secondary students may eat together: outdoors, indoors, with a minimum distance of 2 metres maintained between cohorts

-Cafeterias will be used for students to eat lunch (students will need to follow a seating plan)

-Parents/guardians are not allowed to drop off lunches/snacks during the school day - students should bring their lunch with them or go home/out for lunch

-Delivery services such as Uber Eats are not allowed

-The use of gymnasiums, change rooms, weight rooms, indoor physical education equipment and shared outdoor equipment are permitted
