BENEFITS OF SWAC SCHOOL WITHIN A COLLEGE

SWAC students receive a student card and student number which grants them access to all of the college's facilities.

SWAC students have access to an academic advisor who will assist them in the college application process from start to finish.

SWAC students participate in workshops that cover topics such as financial literacy, employment services, financial aid, student health and wellness.

SWAC students who have an IEP can access Seneca College's student services department to assist students who require academic accommodations.

Fall session SWAC students are eligible to start a full time college program in January.

This is a great opportunity for students who did not graduate with their peers.

Students who graduate from SWAC are eligible for a \$1000 1st Year Bursary when they continue their studies at Seneca College

To date \$50,000 dollars in bursaries have been distributed to students from the York Catholic DSB
